Conserve Our Water

As the summer time heat approaches, we expect to see our daily water consumption more than double. Our observations in past years show that the majority of this increase will go to lawn irrigation, and the heaviest days are Monday and Wednesday mornings. This creates a very heavy peak demand on our water system and the annual surprise of large water bills. During this time of high useage, our storage tanks are depleted faster than we can refill, resulting in pressure drops. When that happens we have to enforce mandatory drought contingency plan restrictions as we did last summer. With this in mind, I would like to ask for a community effort to achieve two goals; Spread the demand evenly throughout the week and save you money.

In order to even out the heavy peak loading on our system we need residents to irrigate:

- Even number addresses {0,2,4,6,8} irrigate on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.
- Odd number addresses {1,3,5,7,9} irrigate on Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday.

In order to save money you can:

- Water early in the morning or late evening to reduce evaporation.
- Be sure not to over water.
- Check your programmable irrigation system to insure the schedule remains accurate. Last year we found a large number of systems were watering far longer than the customer expected, resulting in high water bills.
