Charter Commission Meeting Minutes
Regular Session

1. Call to Order and announce a quorum is present.
2. Welcome and introduction by Mayor Green
 - Mayor Green gives short summary of what goals are to be expected from the Commission Board. Then turns floor over to CM Dalton to give further information.
 - CM Dalton expresses appreciation to Commission Board for getting together in short notice. Request members to write down contact information. Introduces Grady Randle and gives some background on who he is and how they know each other. Gives the floor to Grady Randle.
3. Introduction and Charter overview by City Attorney, Grady Randle.
 - Grady Randle starts off by having the charter members stand and introduce themselves. CM Dalton introduces additional staff. Introductions are completed.
 - Grady Randle gives some personal and professional history about himself. Randle explains how he would like the meeting ran and what he expects from them.
 - Randle discusses in detail Home Rule and the differences between Home Rule and General Law. Then takes time to thoroughly go through the Charter Commission Packet and open the floor for questions.
4. Consider nominations and election of Commission Chair. James (Jimbo) Snyder is nominated and elected Chair of the Charter Commission.
5. Consider nominations and election of Commission Vice Chair. Dwayne Gossett is elected Vice Chair.
6. Discussion and possible action regarding a Charter recommendation completion date. November was decided upon as feasible completion date.
7. Set next meeting date. Following meeting will be held every other Friday at 2:00pm at the Community Center. If scheduling conflicts occur at Community Center, meeting will be held at that time at City Hall Library.
