

MPR Pool Rules 2020

1. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by a 16 year or older guardian.
2. All swimmers must wear a swimsuit.
3. No running, pushing, dunking, or diving in the pool area.
4. No horseplay.
5. No inserting toys or any other objects in pool pipes.
6. No food or large rafts in the pool.
7. No glass containers, alcohol, or any cigarette products in the pool area.
8. No pets allowed in the pool area.

New COVID-19 Rules:

In compliance with Governor Abbott's order, the pool will operate at 25% of capacity. The maximum pool capacity is 50, and 25% means that no more than 12 swimmers will be allowed in the pool at a time. In order to give everyone an opportunity to swim, the following rules will be implemented.

1. Time slots are allocated to 2 hours and will be sold on a first come, first serve basis.
2. Patrons are required to have their temperature taken via non-contact thermometer before entering the pool area. Any patrons with a fever or who refuse will be denied entry.
3. All swimmers will be issued a wristband, which they must be wearing in order to use the pool. Any swimmers attempting to swim without a wristband will be asked to leave the pool immediately.
4. Wristbands are only valid for an allotted time period. Once pool a break is called, all swimmers must leave the premises, regardless of the specific time their wristband was sold during the 2-hour time slot. After the 2 hours are over, wristbands will be cut upon exiting the facility.
5. Because we are trying to give everyone an equal opportunity to use the pool under the current restrictions, patrons must pay for a new wristband if they wish to swim again after their time period has expired. New swimmers will be given priority, and if there is room, repeat patrons may purchase another wristband. This will be managed by the pool staff.
6. Parents or guardians may enter and use the benches or lawn for free, but will not be issued a wristband, and may not swim in the pool. Visitors must be accompanying a swimming patron in order to enter, and must respect a minimum of 6 feet between non-household members.

Rates:

\$3.00 per swimmer, children ages 3 and under enter free with the purchase of guardian entry fee.

\$1 per snack (chips, cookies, etc.)

\$1 per drink (water & Gatorade)

Time Slots:

Pool Opens Saturday, May 23, 2020! Since kids are home already, the pool will be open during the week of May 25th, please enjoy!

Aerobics -- T & Th -- 9AM to 10AM

Aerobics -- M -- 7PM to 8PM

Kids Swim -- Age 0 to 10 -- Every weekday from 10:30 to Noon

Mondays are CLOSED for cleaning and maintenance, EXCEPT for Memorial Day.

Tuesdays to Friday -- 12:15PM to 2:15PM, 2:30PM to 4:30PM, 4:45PM to 6:45PM, 7:00PM to 9:00PM

Saturday -- 10:00AM to 12:00PM, 12:15PM to 2:15PM, 2:30PM to 4:30PM, 4:45PM to 6:45PM, 7:00PM to 9:00PM

Sunday -- 12:15PM to 2:15PM, 2:30PM to 4:30PM, 4:45PM to 6:45PM, 7:00PM to 9:00PM

Notes:

Gate sales start at Noon, Tue through Friday, and on Sunday. Gates sales begin at 9:45 AM on Saturday. No advanced reservations can be taken -- strictly first come first serve. Every measure is being taken to give everyone a chance to enjoy the pool.

Because we have no idea if the social distancing restrictions will be lifted or re-issued, no pool passes will be sold this season. In addition, no pool parties will be booked this season, however, the pool will operate for extended hours to the public. Again, this is to give all citizens a place to go and have fun.

Example of Covid19 rules: Patrons will only be allowed to utilize the pool area during the time slot which they arrived and purchased a wristband, i.e. if one arrives at 12 pm, they may stay until 2 pm, and then must leave. If a patron comes between these hours, say at 1 pm, they will still only be permitted to stay until the 2 pm break. All patrons will be informed of this change before wristbands are purchased.

All chairs and tables will be disinfected during pool breaks before the next round of patrons may utilize them.
